The Winnebago County Medical Society 2023 Annual Meeting was held on Wednesday, March 13, 2024 at Mauh-Nah-Tee-See Club.

W. Stephen Minore, MD, President, thanked everyone for attending. He talked about the importance of belonging to organized medicine and that the only entity that represents physicians in the legislature is ISMS. Dr. Minore discussed the importance of the Website, it being the only site that is run



by doctors for doctors. He thanked Tiffanie Ferry for all her time and effort put forth on the site. The site will be able to generate income from advertising. We need to be innovative in our future endeavors. Insurance companies continue to question doctors' qualifications and take time away from patients and practice. - The Governor's plan to introduce The Healthcare Consumer Access and Protection Act which will curb predatory insurance practices and address other health insurance issues.

ISMS worked with physicians and pharmacists to educate all affected parties on the e-prescribing mandate that went into effect on January 1.
